



2016-2018 SALT LAKE CO. DELEGATE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Congratulations on being elected a Salt Lake County Republican Delegate! Your willingness to participate in the Party and the political process is greatly appreciated. This sheet will hopefully provide a few details of your new responsibilities and what is expected.

First, remember that each County Delegate must be a registered affiliated Republican. To be seated, the Salt Lake County Republican Party must have a record of your name, telephone number, mailing address AND valid email address in its files. The name you use should be the exact name you used to register to vote. As a County Delegate, you will receive important communications from the State and County GOP, Elected Officials and GOP Candidates.

The term of service for all delegates is two years. Should you move or change addresses during that time, please inform your Precinct Chair and Legislative Chair. *If you unaffiliate from the Republican Party during your tenure, you will be replaced by your Precinct Chair.*

For the near future, your biggest responsibility is to attend and participate in the *2016 Salt Lake County Republican Party Nominating Convention*. It will be held on **Saturday, April 16th at Cottonwood High School**. The official *Call to Convention* with Agenda and instructions will be mailed to you. Please plan on attending Convention for the full day.

At the convention, county delegates, by casting ballots, will choose the Party's nominees for elected offices. The offices you will be voting for include State Legislative Offices and County Elected Offices.

As a County Delegate, it is your responsibility to educate yourself about all the candidates and to represent your Precinct. You have a short window of time to learn about the candidates! Expect to receive mailings, phone calls, invitations, etc. from Candidates during their campaign to become the GOP Nominee for specific offices. Please read the material they send to you and attend "Meet the Candidate" events and other opportunities to listen to and become acquainted with them. As you gather information, communicate your findings to your precinct and solicit feedback from them regarding who they would like as the nominee. Remember, *you represent your precinct!* Work with your precinct chair to communicate with your fellow Republicans.

At the convention you may also have the chance to debate and vote on other issues important to Salt Lake County Republicans. Convention can be an exciting and fun experience.

YOU MUST also plan on attending the 2017 County Organizing Convention next year where the County Party Officers and our State Central Committee members will be selected by YOU, the County Delegates.
