

Voting for one (1) position. 100 voters, vote for one (1)

Larry	Received 30 votes	No individual wins due to no one received 50% plus one (1) vote. How do you determine who moves on to the second (2 nd) round?
Sharon	Received 19 votes	
Mo	Received 18 votes	
Jane	Received 17 votes	
Curly	Received 16 votes	

Larry, Sharon and Mo move to second round. Jane and Curly drop. You must combine the highest vote getters until they equal 50% + One (1) vote. Larry and Sharon received a total of 49% of the vote. Therefore Mo moves to second round with Larry and Sharon to surpass the threshold of 50% + one (1) vote.

Second (2nd) Round

Larry	Received 49 votes	No individual wins due to no one received 50% plus one (1) vote. How do you determine who moves on to the third (3 rd) round?
Sharon	Received 40 votes	
Mo	Received 11 votes	

Larry and Sharon move to third round. Mo drops. You must combine the most vote getters until they equal 50% + One (1) vote. Larry received a total of 49% of the vote. Therefore Sharon moves to third round with Larry because combined they surpass the threshold of 50% + one (1) vote.

Third (3rd) Round

Larry	Received 60 votes	<u>Larry is the winner</u>
Sharon	Received 35 votes	

There were less than 100 votes cast because some people left the Caucus meeting prior to casting their third round ballot.
