

Voting for three (3) positions, 100 voters, Vote for three (3)

Larry Received 78 votes

Larry won one (1) of the three positions

Sharon Received 69 votes

Sharon won the second (2nd) of the three positions

Mo Received 35 votes

How do you determine who moves on to the

Jane Received 34 votes

second (2nd) round?

Curly Received 30 votes

Larry and Sharon were elected because they received 50% + 1 or more of the votes cast. Mo and Jane move to the second (2nd) round and Curly drops. You must combine the most vote getters until they equal 50% + One (1) vote or more. Mo received a total of 35% of the vote. Jane received 34% of the vote. Therefore Jane moves to second (2nd) round with Mo because combined Mo and Jane surpassed the threshold of 50% + one (1) vote.

Second (2nd) Round, One (1) position remains. Vote for one (1)

Mo Received 63 votes

Mo wins third (3rd) and final position.

Jane Received 37 votes

You must take enough candidates to the next round to equal 50% + 1 of the votes cast.
